8	this Chapter shall prohibit an employee of the State Parks Division
9	of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department from accepting a
10	gratuity if:
11	(1) the employee serves food and beverages as a
12	primary job duty in a restaurant, cafeteria or other food service
13	establishment within a State Park owned and operated by the Texas
14	Parks and Wildlife Department;
15	(2) the gratuity is offered by a customer of the
16	restaurant, cafeteria or other food service establishment in
17	appreciation for the service of food or beverages;
18	(3) the employee served food or beverages to the
19	customer offering the gratuity;
20	(4) the employee has been designated by the Texas
21	Parks and Wildlife Department as being authorized to receive a
22	gratuity; and,
