5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 382, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 382.0592 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 382.0592. LIMITATIONS RELATED TO OPERATIONS OF MOBILE
8	ROCK CRUSHERS. (a) This section applies only to the location and
9	operation of a rock crusher that may be moved and operated in
10	different locations.
11	(b) A rock crusher may not be operated less than one mile
12	from any recreational area or from a residence or other structure

- (b) A rock crusher may not be operated less than one mile from any recreational area or from a residence or other structure that is occupied or used by a person other than the operator of the rock crusher or the owner of the property on which the rock crusher is operated.
- 16 <u>(c) Aggregate, rock, or gravel piles maintained in the</u>
 17 vicinity of a rock crusher may not exceed a height of 15 feet.
- 18 <u>(d) The commission shall adopt rules to implement this</u> 19 section.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
