- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 22, Government Code, is

- 7 Sec. 22.2121. APPELLATE JUDICIAL SYSTEM. (a) The
- 8 <u>commissioners court of each county in the Eleventh Court of Appeals</u>
- 9 District by order entered in its minutes shall establish an
- 10 appellate judicial system to:
- 11 (1) assist the court of appeals for the county in the
- 12 processing of appeals filed with the court of appeals from the
- 13 county courts, statutory county courts, probate courts, and
- 14 district courts; and
- 15 (2) defray costs and expenses incurred by the county

- 17 (b) To fund the system, the commissioners court shall set a
- 18 court costs fee of \$5 for each civil suit filed in county court,
- 19 statutory county court, probate court, or district court in the

- 21 (c) The court costs fee does not apply to a suit filed by the
- 22 county or to a suit for delinquent taxes.
- 23 (d) The court costs fee shall be taxed, collected, and paid

- 1 the court costs fee set under this section and pay it to the county
- 2 officer who performs the county treasurer's functions. That
- 3 officer shall deposit the fee in a separate appellate justice
- 4 system fund. The commissioners court shall establish and maintain
- 5 the fund to assist the court of appeals district. The fund may not
- 6 be used for any other purpose.
- 7 <u>(e) The commissioners court has the authority necessary to</u>
- 8 assist the court of appeals in the administration and management of
- 9 the system and to contract with any private corporation, public
- 10 corporation, or a combination of those corporations.
- 11 (f) The commissioners court shall vest management of the
- 12 system in the chief justice of the court of appeals.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
