(a) 7 The department shall issue specifically designed Keeping Texas 8 9 Strong license plates for passenger cars and light trucks. (b) The license plate must include the words "Keeping Texas 10 Strong." 11 12 (c) The department shall design the license plate in consultation with the Texas Alliance of Energy Producers. 13 14 (d) The department shall issue license plates under this section to a person who: 15 (1) applies to the county tax assessor-collector of 16 the county in which the person resides on a form provided by the 17 18 department; and (2) pays an annual fee of \$30.00 in addition to the fee 19 prescribed by Section 502.161 and, if personalized prestige license 20 21 plates are issued, in addition to the fee prescribed by Section 502.251. 22 23 (e) Of each fee collected under subsection (d): (1) \$22.00 shall be deposited to the credit of the 24

5	(f) If the license plates issued under this section are
6	lost, stolen, or mutilated, the owner of the vehicle for which the

9	502.184(a)(2).
10	(g) If the owner of a vehicle registered under this Section
11	disposes of the vehicle during the registration year, the owner
12	shall return the special license plates to the department.
