## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to requiring state agencies to report on legal matters.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. (a) In this section, "state agency" means a
- 5 department, commission, board, office, or other agency that is in
- 6 the executive or legislative branch of state government and is
- 7 created by the constitution or a statute of this state, including a
- 8 university system or an institution of higher education as defined
- 9 by Section 61.003, Education Code.
- 10 (b) Not later than March 1, 2004, each state agency shall
- 11 file a written report with the state affairs committees of the
- 12 senate and the house of representatives stating:
- 13 (1) whether the state agency uses agency employees,
- 14 the attorney general, or other counsel to represent the agency in
- 15 legal matters, and if the agency uses more than one counsel to
- 16 represent the agency, the agency shall describe the type of legal
- work each counsel performs for the agency;
- 18 (2) the amount of money the state agency spent during
- 19 the previous fiscal biennium relating to legal matters, including
- 20 the amount spent on litigation matters and administrative matters;
- 21 and
- 22 (3) the number of state agency employees working on
- 23 legal matters, including attorneys and other employees, and a
- 24 description of the employees' job duties.
