A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to loan repayment assistance for certain social workers
3	who work for the Department of Protective and Regulatory Services.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 61, Education Code, is amended by adding
6	Subchapter Z to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER Z. REPAYMENT OF CERTAIN SOCIAL WORKER EDUCATION LOANS
8	Sec. 61.9701. REPAYMENT ASSISTANCE AUTHORIZED. (a) The
9	board shall provide, in accordance with this subchapter and board
10	rules, assistance in the repayment of education loans for social
11	workers who apply and qualify for the assistance.
12	(b) The provision of financial assistance in the repayment
13	of education loans under this subchapter promotes a public purpose.
14	Sec. 61.9702. ELIGIBILITY. To be eligible to receive
15	repayment assistance, a person must:
16	(1) apply to the board;
17	(2) have graduated from an accredited public or
18	private institution of higher education in or outside this state
19	with a baccalaureate or graduate degree in social work; and
20	(3) currently work as a social worker for the
21	Department of Protective and Regulatory Services.
22	Sec. 61.9703. LIMITATIONS. (a) A social worker may receive
23	repayment assistance grants for each of not more than five years.
24	(b) The amount of loan repayment assistance received by a

- 1 social worker under this subchapter in one year may not exceed 20
- 2 percent of the total amount of the social worker's outstanding
- 3 education loans, including scheduled interest payments that would
- 4 become due if the loan is not prepaid, when the social worker enters
- 5 into the agreement.
- 6 Sec. 61.9704. ELIGIBLE LOANS. (a) The board may provide
- 7 repayment assistance for the repayment of any education loan
- 8 received by the social worker through any lender for education
- 9 while enrolled at an institution of higher education described by
- 10 Section 61.9702(2) in a baccalaureate or graduate degree program in
- 11 social work.
- 12 (b) The board may not provide repayment assistance for an
- 13 education loan that is in default at the time of the social worker's
- 14 application.
- Sec. 61.9705. REPAYMENT. (a) The board shall deliver any
- 16 repayment assistance made under this subchapter in a lump sum
- 17 payable to the lender and the social worker and in accordance with
- 18 any applicable federal law.
- 19 (b) Loan repayment assistance received under this
- subchapter may be applied to the principal amount of the loan and to
- 21 <u>interest that accrues.</u>
- Sec. 61.9706. ADVISORY COMMITTEE. The board may appoint an
- 23 advisory committee from outside the board's membership to assist
- the board in performing the board's duties under this subchapter.
- Sec. 61.707. ACCEPTANCE OF GIFTS. The board may solicit and
- 26 accept gifts, grants, and donations for the purposes of this
- 27 subchapter.

- Sec. 61.9708. RULES. The board shall adopt rules necessary
- 2 for the administration of this subchapter.
- 3 SECTION 2. The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board
- 4 shall adopt the rules for the repayment assistance program under
- 5 Subchapter Z, Chapter 61, Education Code, as added by this Act, not
- 6 later than December 1, 2003.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
