- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 9.516(b), Business & Commerce Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6
- Filing does not occur with respect to a record that a 7 filing office refuses to accept because: 8
- (1) the record is not communicated by a method or 9 medium of communication authorized by the filing office; 10
- 11 (2) an amount equal to or greater than the applicable 12 filing fee is not tendered;
- (3) the filing office is unable to index the record 13 14 because:
- (A) financing in the case of an initial 15 statement, the record does not provide a name for the debtor; 16
- (B) in the case of an amendment or correction 17 18 statement, the record:
- (i) does not identify the initial financing 19
- statement as required by Section 9.512 or 9.518, as applicable; or 20
- 21 (ii) identifies an initial financing
- 22 statement whose effectiveness has lapsed under Section 9.515;
- (C) in the case of an initial financing statement 23
- that provides the name of a debtor identified as an individual or an 24

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- 1 amendment that provides a name of a debtor identified as an
- 2 individual that was not previously provided in the financing
- 3 statement to which the record relates, the record does not identify
- 4 the debtor's last name; or
- 5 (D) in the case of a record filed or recorded in
- 6 the filing office described in Section 9.501(a)(1), the record does
- 7 not provide a sufficient description of the real property to which
- 8 it relates;
- 9 (4) in the case of an initial financing statement or an
- 10 amendment that adds a secured party of record, the record does not
- 11 provide a name and mailing address for the secured party of record;
- 12 (5) in the case of an initial financing statement or an
- 13 amendment that provides a name of a debtor that was not previously
- 14 provided in the financing statement to which the amendment relates,
- 15 the record does not:
- 16 (A) provide a mailing address for the debtor;
- 17 (B) indicate whether the debtor is an individual
- 18 or an organization; or
- 19 (C) if the financing statement indicates that the
- 20 debtor is an organization, provide:
- 21 (i) a type of organization for the debtor;
- 22 (ii) a jurisdiction of organization for the
- 23 debtor; or
- 24 (iii) an organizational identification
- 25 number for the debtor or indicate that the debtor has none;
- 26 (6) in the case of an assignment reflected in an
- 27 initial financing statement under Section 9.514(a) or an amendment

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- filed under Section 9.514(b), the record does not provide a name and
- 2 mailing address for the assignee; [ex]
- 3 (7) in the case of a continuation statement, the
- 4 record is not filed within the six-month period prescribed by
- 5 Section 9.515(d); or
- 6 (8) the record is not on an industry standard form,
- 7 including a national standard form or a form approved by the
- 8 International Association of Commercial Administrators, adopted by
- 9 rule by the secretary of state.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter E, Chapter 9, Business & Commerce
- 11 Code, is amended by adding Section 9.5211 to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 9.5211. UNIFORM FORM OF WRITTEN FINANCING STATEMENT
- 13 AND AMENDMENT. (a) Except as provided by Section 9.516(b), a
- 14 filing office that accepts written records may not refuse to accept
- a written initial financing statement on an industry standard form,
- 16 including a national standard form or a form approved by the
- 17 International Association of Commercial Administrators, adopted by
- 18 rule by the secretary of state.
- (b) Except as provided by Section 9.516(b), a filing office
- 20 that accepts written records may not refuse to accept a written
- 21 record on an industry standard form, including a national standard
- 22 form or a form approved by the International Association of
- 23 Commercial Administrators, adopted by rule by the secretary of
- 24 state.
- 25 SECTION 3. Section 9.521, Business & Commerce Code, is
- 26 repealed.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect January 1, 2004, and

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- 1 applies only to a financing statement or written record due to be
- 2 filed on or after that date. A financing statement or written
- 3 record due to be filed before the effective date of this Act is
- 4 governed by the law in effect at the time the filing was made, and
- 5 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
