- 9 Code, is amended by adding Section 16.22 to read as follows:
- Sec. 16.22. ELECTRONIC FILING AND REPRODUCTION. (a) The
- 11 following instruments may be filed in an electronic format that is
- 12 approved by the secretary of state:
