A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to powers of the governor as the chief executive officer of
- 3 the state and the organization and efficiency of state agencies.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Section 401, Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 401.041. CHIEF BUDGET OFFICER. The governor is the
- 8 chief budget officer of the state.
- 9 Sec. 401.042. UNIFORM BUDGET ESTIMATE FORMS. (a) The
- 10 governor may collaborate with the Legislative Budget Board in
- 11 designing and preparing uniform budget estimate forms on which all
- 12 requests for legislative appropriations must be prepared.
- 13 (b) The governor shall require that all appropriation
- 14 requests be submitted to the governor on the forms.
- Sec. 401.043. BUDGET HEARINGS. (a) After receiving the
- 16 appropriation requests, the governor shall hold one or more public
- 17 hearings concerning the requests. The governor shall preside at
- 18 each hearing, except that the governor may authorize any employee
- of the executive branch to preside and represent the governor in the
- 20 governor's absence.
- 21 (b) The head of a state agency that is seeking
- 22 appropriations is entitled to speak at a hearing under this section
- 23 at which the appropriation request is considered. The governor may
- 24 require the head or any employee of a state agency seeking

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- 1 appropriations to appear at the hearing and present information
- 2 about the appropriations. A taxpayer is entitled to participate in
- 3 the discussion at a hearing under this section of any item proposed
- 4 to be included in the budget under consideration.
- 5 (c) In this section, "state agency" means a board,
- 6 commission, department, or other agency in the executive or
- 7 judicial branch of state government.
- 8 Sec. 401.044. COOPERATION WITH LEGISLATIVE BUDGET BOARD.
- 9 (a) The governor and the Legislative Budget Board may cooperate,
- 10 exchange information, and hold joint public hearings on the
- 11 biennial appropriation budget.
- 12 (b) At a joint hearing under this section, the governor
- 13 shall preside or, if the governor is unable to preside:
- 14 (1) the lieutenant governor shall preside; or
- 15 (2) a person appointed by the governor and the
- 16 lieutenant governor shall preside.
- 17 Sec. 401.0445. COMPILATION OF THE BUDGET. (a) The governor
- 18 may [shall] compile the biennial appropriation budget using
- 19 information:
- 20 (1) submitted to the governor in the uniform budget
- 21 estimate forms; and
- 22 (2) obtained at public hearings, from inspections, and
- 23 from other sources.
- (b) In the budget, the governor may [shall] show:
- 25 (1) the list of appropriations for the current year
- 26 preceding the biennium for which appropriations are sought and
- 27 recommended;

- 1 (2) expenditures for $[\frac{each \ of}{}]$ the $\frac{year}{}$ $[\frac{two \ full}{}]$
- 2 years] preceding the current year; and
- 3 (3) the amounts requested by the various agencies and
- 4 the amounts recommended by the governor for each of the years of the
- 5 biennium.
- 6 Sec. 401.045. LEGISLATIVE EXPENSES. The governor may not
- 7 include in the governor's budget or appropriation bill any
- 8 appropriation for per diem or mileage expenses of members of the
- 9 legislature or for necessary expenses of the legislature.
- Sec. 401.046. DISTRIBUTION OF BUDGET. (a) The governor may
- 11 [shall] deliver a copy of the governor's budget to each member of
- 12 the legislature [not later than the sixth day of each regular
- 13 legislative session].
- 14 (b) The governor shall have as many copies of the budget
- 15 printed for public distribution as the governor considers
- 16 necessary.
- 17 [Sec. 401.047. PENALTY. A person who refuses to comply with
- 18 a provision of this subchapter other than Section 401.044 commits
- 19 an offense. An offense under this section is punishable by a fine
- 20 of not less than \$100 or more than \$1,000, confinement in county
- 21 jail for not less than one month or more than one year, or both fine
- 22 and confinement.
- Sec. 401.048. ANNUAL BUDGETS. A reference in this
- 24 subchapter or in Chapter 322 to a biennial budget or a regular
- 25 legislative session means an annual budget or an annual budget
- 26 session if a constitutional amendment is adopted providing for
- 27 annual budget sessions of the legislature.

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- 1 SECTION 2. Chapter 2083, Government Code, is repealed.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
