SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter C, Chapter 115, 6

Natural Resources Code, is amended to read as follows: 7

- 5 SECTION 6. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 6 (b) The changes in law made by Sections 115.031, 115.032,
- 7 and 115.033, Natural Resources Code, as amended by this Act, and
- 8 Section 115.035, Natural Resources Code, as added by this Act,
- 9 apply only to an offense committed on or after September 1, 2003.
- 10 For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before
- 11 September 1, 2003, if any element of the offense occurs before that
- date. An offense committed before September 1, 2003, is covered by
- 13 the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former law
- 14 is continued in effect for that purpose.
