7 Sec. 85.321. SUIT FOR DAMAGES. A party who owns an interest

in property or production that may be damaged by another party

violating the provisions of this chapter that were formerly a part

- 8 SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 9 (b) The changes in law made by this Act to Sections 85.321 10 and 85.322, Natural Resources Code, apply only to an action for 11 damages brought on or after September 1, 2003. An action brought 12 before that date is governed by the law in effect on the date the 13 action is brought, and the former law is continued in effect for 14 that purpose.
