4	SECTION 1. This Act may be called the Baby Lauren Gomez Act.
5	SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 756, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 756.014 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 756.014. LABELING REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTAIN BUCKETS.
8	(a) A person may not sell or offer for sale a bucket with a volume
9	of not less than four gallons or more than six gallons unless the
10	bucket is labeled in accordance with this section.
11	(b) A label under this section must:
12	(1) be easily removable only by the use of a tool or a
13	solvent;
14	(2) be placed on the side of the bucket near where the
15	handle inserts into the bucket; and
16	(3) display, on a contrasting background:
17	(A) the words, in both English and Spanish:
18	(i) "WARNING;" and
19	(ii) "Children may fall into bucket and drown
20	- keep children away from bucket even if it only contains a small
21	<pre>amount of water;"</pre>
22	(B) the likeness of a child reaching into a
23	bucket under an encircled slash; and
24	(C) an exclamation point contrasted against and

- 1 enclosed by a triangle to the left of the word "WARNING."
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
