- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 152.906, Local Government Code, is 5 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 152.906. LONGEVITY PAY [FOR DEPUTY GENERALLY 6 7 CONSTABLES]. Except as provided by Section 152.074, a [In a county with a population of 190,000 or more, the] commissioners court may 8 provide for each <u>district</u>, county, or <u>precinct</u> employee or 9 classification of those employees [county employee, including, but 10 not limited to, deputy constables, longevity pay[ $\tau$ ] in addition to 11 12 regular compensation on terms and in an amount determined by the commissioners court [, of \$5 a month, or any other amount determined 13 by the commissioners court, for each year of service in the county, 14 up to and including 30 years]. 15
- SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 41, Government Code, is repealed.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
