- 8 (a) A person commits an offense if by any means, including
- 9 electronic communication, the person [he] threatens to commit any
- 10 offense involving violence to any person or property with intent
- 11 to:
- 12 (1) cause a reaction of any type to the person's [his]
- 13 threat by an official or volunteer agency organized to deal with
- 14 emergencies;
- 15 (2) place any person in fear of imminent serious
- 16 bodily injury; or
- 17 (3) prevent or interrupt the occupation or use of a
- 18 building; room; place of assembly; place to which the public has
- 19 access; place of employment or occupation; school or similar
- 20 <u>educational institution;</u> aircraft, automobile, or other form of
- 21 conveyance; or other public place; or
- 22 (4) cause impairment or interruption of public
- 23 communications, public transportation, public water, gas, or power
- 24 supply or other public service.
