- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.021, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 42.021. EXTENT OF EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION. (a)
- 8 Except as provided by Subsection (b), the [The] extraterritorial
- 9 jurisdiction of a municipality is the unincorporated area that is
- 10 contiguous to the corporate boundaries of the municipality and that
- 11 is located:
- 12 (1) within one-half mile of those boundaries, in the
- 13 case of a municipality with fewer than 5,000 inhabitants;
- 14 (2) within one mile of those boundaries, in the case of
- a municipality with 5,000 to 24,999 inhabitants;
- 16 (3) within two miles of those boundaries, in the case
- of a municipality with 25,000 to 49,999 inhabitants;
- 18 (4) within 3 1/2 miles of those boundaries, in the case
- of a municipality with 50,000 to 99,999 inhabitants; or
- 20 (5) within five miles of those boundaries, in the case
- of a municipality with 100,000 or more inhabitants.
- 22 (b) The extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality is
- 23 the unincorporated area that is contiguous to the corporate
- 24 boundaries of the municipality and that is located within one mile

- 1 of those boundaries if the municipality:
- 2 (1) has a population of more than 2,000 and less than
- 3 25,000; and
- 4 (2) is located in whole or in part in:

- 7 <u>(B) a county adjacent to a county with a</u>

- 9 SECTION 2. Subchapter Z, Chapter 42, Local Government Code,
- is amended by adding Section 42.9011 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 42.9011. APPORTIONMENT OF EXTRATERRITORIAL
- 12 JURISDICTIONS OF CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES THAT OVERLAPPED ON
- SEPTEMBER 1, 2003. (a) If, on September 1, 2003, the expanded
- 14 extraterritorial jurisdiction that a municipality received under
- 15 Section 42.021(b) overlapped the expanded extraterritorial
- 16 jurisdiction that one or more other municipalities received on that
- date under Section 42.021(b), the governing bodies of the affected
- municipalities may apportion the overlapped area in the same manner
- 19 as provided by Section 42.901.
- 20 (b) The expansion of the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a
- 21 <u>municipality under Section 42.021(b) may not include any area in</u>
- 22 the existing extraterritorial jurisdiction of another
- 23 municipality.
- (c) In applying Section 42.901(c) for purposes of this
- 25 section, the date of September 1, 2003, is substituted for August
- 26 23, 1963.
