1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to naming the school of pharmacy at Texas A&M  
1-11 University--Kingsville and its physical facility after Irma  
1-12 Rangel.

1-13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-14 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 87.303, Education Code,  
1-15 is amended to read as follows:

1-16 Sec. 87.303. IRMA RANGEL SCHOOL OF PHARMACY.

1-17 SECTION 2. Section 87.303(a), Education Code, is amended to  
1-18 read as follows:

1-19 (a) The board of regents of The Texas A&M University System  
1-20 may establish and maintain a school of pharmacy as a professional  
1-21 school of Texas A&M University--Kingsville. The school shall be  
1-22 known as the Irma Rangel School of Pharmacy, and the primary  
1-23 building in which the school is operated must include "Irma Rangel"  
1-24 in its official name.

1-25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-28 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-29 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
