## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to motor vehicle inspection facilities near the border of

3 this state and Mexico.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 201.613, Transportation Code, is amended

6 to read as follows:

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7 Sec. 201.613. [ONE-STOP] BORDER INSPECTION FACILITIES

8 [STATIONS]. (a) The department shall erect and maintain eight

border [choose a location for an] inspection facilities not farther

than 60 miles from the Rio Grande [station along a major highway at

11 or near a border crossing from Mexico] in the Pharr [Brownsville],

[in] Laredo, and [in] El Paso districts for the inspection of motor

vehicles after the vehicles have been inspected for compliance with

federal regulations [so that all federal, state, and municipal

agencies that regulate the passage of persons or vehicles across

16 the border at that border crossing may be located in one place].

17 (b) <u>If a facility serves a bridge system that has more than</u>

500,000 commercial border crossings per year is to be located in a

19 municipality or a municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction,

the municipality may choose the location of the facility within the

21 municipality or the municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction.

The city shall choose the location within 180 days of a request by

23 the department to do so. [The department shall establish and

24 maintain an inspection station at the locations chosen in

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- 1 Subsection (a) only if the federal agencies involved in the
- 2 regulation of the passage of persons or vehicles at that border
- 3 crossing agree to the design of the facility at each location and
- 4 agree to use the facility at each location if built].
- 5 (c) The department shall begin construction of the
- 6 facilities at or about the same time and shall take reasonable steps
- 7 to ensure that construction of the facilities progresses equally
- 8 [The department may enter into agreements with federal, state, and
- 9 municipal agencies to accomplish the purpose of this section. An
- 10 agreement may involve the lease of office space at the inspection
- 11 station by the department to the agency].
- 12 SECTION 2. The Texas Department of Transportation shall
- 13 spend the money appropriated during the 76th Legislature for
- 14 Section 201.613, Transportation Code, as added by Chapter 1527,
- 15 Acts of the 76th Legislature, Regular Session, 1999, or money
- 16 received from the federal government to establish the border
- inspection facilities under Section 201.613, Transportation Code,
- 18 as amended by this Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 20 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 21 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 22 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
