- 3 operation, and financing of the Williamson County Municipal Utility
- 4 District No. 12.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS. In this Act:
- 7 (1) "Board" means the board of directors of the
- 8 district.
- 9 (2) "Commission" means the Texas Commission on
- 10 Environmental Quality.
- 11 (3) "District" means the Williamson County Municipal
- 12 Utility District No. 12.
- SECTION 2. CREATION. (a) A municipal utility district, to
- 14 be known as the Williamson County Municipal Utility District No.
- 15 12, is created in Williamson County, subject to approval at a
- 16 confirmation election under Section 9 of this Act.
- 17 (b) The district is a governmental agency and a political
- 18 subdivision of this state.
- 19 SECTION 3. FINDINGS OF BENEFIT AND PUBLIC PURPOSE. (a) The
- 20 district is created to serve a public use and benefit.
- 21 (b) The district is created under and is essential to
- 22 accomplish the purposes of Section 59, Article XVI, Texas
- 23 Constitution.
- (c) All of the land and other property included within the

- 1 boundaries of the district will be benefited by the works and
- 2 projects that are to be accomplished by the district under powers
- 3 conferred by Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution.
- 4 SECTION 4. BOUNDARIES. The boundaries of the district are
- 5 as follows:
- 6 Tract 1. A 357.494 acre tract of land situated in the
- 7 Greenleaf Fisk Survey, Abstract No. 5, Williamson County, Texas,
- 8 and being all of a called 87.00 acre tract as described in Volume

- 8 herein-described tract, being the northwest corner of said 0.7764
- 9 acre tract and being in the south right-of-way line of State Highway
- 10 No. 29,;
- 11 THENCE, South  $88^{\circ}45'00''$  East, 80.81 feet, along the south
- 12 right-of-way line of State Highway No. 29, to the POINT OF BEGINNING
- and containing a computed area of 357.494 acres or (15,572,458
- 14 Square Feet) of land.
- Tract 2. A 87.0 acre tract of land, more or less, more
- 16 particularly described in a conveyance to East Belt, Ltd., recorded
- 17 as Document No. 200039722 in the Official Records of Williamson
- 18 County, Texas.
- 19 SECTION 5. FINDINGS RELATIVE TO BOUNDARIES. The
- 20 legislature finds that the boundaries and field notes of the
- 21 district form a closure. If a mistake is made in the field notes or
- in copying the field notes in the legislative process, the mistake
- 23 does not affect in any way:
- 24 (1) the organization, existence, or validity of the
- 25 district;
- 26 (2) the right of the district to impose taxes; or
- 27 (3) the legality or operation of the district or the

- 1 board.
- 2 SECTION 6. APPLICABILITY OF OTHER LAW. This Act prevails
- 3 over any provision of general law that is in conflict or
- 4 inconsistent with this Act.
- 5 SECTION 7. BOARD OF DIRECTORS. (a) The district is
- 6 governed by a board of five directors.
- 7 (b) Temporary directors serve until initial directors are
- 8 elected under Section 9 of this Act.
- 9 (c) Initial directors serve until permanent directors are
- 10 elected under Section 10 of this Act.
- 11 (d) Permanent directors serve staggered four-year terms.
- 12 (e) Each director must qualify to serve as director in the
- manner provided by Section 49.055, Water Code.
- 14 (f) A director serves until the director's successor has
- 15 qualified.
- 16 SECTION 8. TEMPORARY DIRECTORS. (a) The temporary board
- 17 consists of:
- 18 (1) Rex Bohls;
- 19 (2) Leanna Einhaus;
- 20 (3) Glen Kistenmacher;
- 21 (4) Hagen McMann; and
- 22 (5) Bill Simpson.
- 23 (b) If a temporary director fails to qualify for office, the
- 24 temporary directors who have qualified shall appoint a person to
- 25 fill the vacancy. If at any time there are fewer than three
- 26 qualified temporary directors, the commission shall appoint the
- 27 necessary number of persons to fill all vacancies on the board.

- 1 SECTION 9. CONFIRMATION AND INITIAL DIRECTORS' ELECTION.
- 2 (a) The temporary board of directors shall call and hold an
- 3 election to confirm the establishment of the district and to elect
- 4 five initial directors as provided by Section 49.102, Water Code.
- 5 (b) The initial directors elected shall draw lots to decide
- 6 which two shall serve terms lasting until replacement directors are
- 7 elected at the first regularly scheduled election of directors
- 8 under Section 10 of this Act and which three shall serve until the
- 9 second regularly scheduled election of directors.
- 10 (c) Section 41.001(a), Election Code, does not apply to a
- 11 confirmation and initial directors' election held as provided by
- 12 this section.
- 13 SECTION 10. ELECTION OF DIRECTORS. (a) On the first
- 14 Saturday in May of the first even-numbered year after the year in
- 15 which the district is authorized to be created at a confirmation
- 16 election, an election shall be held in the district for the election
- 17 of two directors to replace the two initial directors serving
- 18 shorter terms from the confirmation election.
- 19 (b) On the first Saturday in May of each subsequent
- 20 even-numbered year following the election, the appropriate number
- 21 of directors shall be elected.
- 22 SECTION 11. GENERAL POWERS. The district has all of the
- 23 rights, powers, privileges, authority, functions, and duties
- 24 provided by the general law of this state, including Chapter 54,
- 25 Water Code, applicable to municipal utility districts created under
- 26 Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution.
- 27 SECTION 12. PROHIBITION AGAINST IMPAIRMENT OF DISTRICT. A

- 1 municipality in whose extraterritorial jurisdiction the district
- 2 is located may not adopt an ordinance or resolution or take any
- 3 other action that:
- 4 (1) impairs the ability of the district to exercise
- 5 its powers under this Act; or
- 6 (2) limits the ability of the district to finance,
- 7 construct, or operate its water, wastewater, or drainage systems.
- 8 SECTION 13. ANNEXATION. (a) A municipality may annex the
- 9 district on the earlier of:
- 10 (1) the date of installation of 90 percent of all
- 11 works, improvements, facilities, plants, equipment, and appliances
- 12 necessary and adequate to:
- 13 (A) provide service to the proposed development
- 14 within the district;
- 15 (B) accomplish the purposes for which the
- 16 district was created; and
- 17 (C) exercise the powers provided by the general
- 18 law of this state and this Act; or
- 19 (2) the 20th anniversary of the date the district is
- 20 confirmed.
- 21 (b) The district may add or exclude land in the manner
- 22 provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, without the consent of
- 23 any municipality.
- 24 SECTION 14. REIMBURSEMENT TO LANDOWNER OR DEVELOPER;
- 25 INSTALLATION OF FACILITIES. If a municipality in whose
- 26 extraterritorial jurisdiction the district is located annexes the
- 27 district for full or limited purposes and the annexation precludes

- 1 or impairs the ability of the district to issue bonds, the
- 2 municipality shall:
- 3 (1) simultaneously with the annexation, pay in cash to
- 4 the landowner or developer of the district a sum equal to all actual
- 5 costs and expenses incurred by the landowner or developer in
- 6 connection with the district that the district has, in writing,
- 7 agreed to pay and that would otherwise have been eligible for
- 8 reimbursement from bond proceeds under the rules and requirements
- 9 of the commission as such rules and requirements exist on the date
- 10 of annexation; and
- 11 (2) after the annexation, install all necessary water,
- 12 wastewater, and drainage facilities to serve full buildout of
- 13 development within the district.
- 14 SECTION 15. FINDINGS RELATED TO PROCEDURAL REQUIREMENTS.
- 15 (a) The legal notice of the intention to introduce this Act,
- 16 setting forth the general substance of this Act, has been published
- 17 as provided by law, and the notice and a copy of this Act have been
- 18 furnished to all persons, agencies, officials, or entities to which
- 19 they are required to be furnished under Section 59, Article XVI,
- 20 Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, Government Code. The
- 21 governor, one of the required recipients, has submitted the notice
- 22 and Act to the commission.
- 23 (b) The commission has filed its recommendations relating
- 24 to this Act with the governor, lieutenant governor, and speaker of
- 25 the house of representatives within the required time.
- 26 (c) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 27 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect

- 1 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 2 and accomplished.
- 3 SECTION 16. EFFECTIVE DATE; EXPIRATION DATE. (a) This Act
- 4 takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 5 (b) If the creation of the district is not confirmed at a
- 6 confirmation election held under Section 9 of this Act before
- 7 September 1, 2005, this Act expires on that date.
