CREATION. FINDINGS OF BENEFIT AND PUBLIC PURPOSE. (a) The 1-26 district is created to serve a public use and benefit. 1-27 (b) The district is created under and is essential to 1-28 accomplish the purposes of Section 59, Article XVI, Texas 1-29 Constitution. SECTION 5. FINDINGS RELATIVE TO BOUNDARIES. The legislature finds that the boundaries and field notes of the district form a closure. If a mistake is made in the field notes or 4-9 4-10 4-11 4-12 in copying the field notes in the legislative process, the mistake 4-13 does not affect in any way: 4 - 14(1)the organization, existence, or validity of the

4-15 district; 4-16

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(2)the right of the district to impose taxes; or

the legality or operation of the district or the (3) board.

APPLICABILITY OF OTHER LAW. SECTION 6. This Act prevails any provision of general law that is in conflict over or inconsistent with this Act.

SECTION 7. BOARD OF DIRECTORS. (a) The district is governed by a board of five directors.

4-24 (b) Temporary directors serve until initial directors are 4-25 elected under Section 9 of this Act.

4-26 (c) Initial directors serve until permanent directors are 4-27 elected under Section 10 of this Act. 4-28

(d) Permanent directors serve staggered four-year terms.

Each director must qualify to serve as director in the (e)

manner provided by Section 49.055, Water Code.
(f) A director serves until the director's successor has qualified.

SECTION 8. TEMPORARY DIRECTORS. (a) The temporary board consists of:

(1)Rex Bohls;

(2) Leanna Einhaus;

(3) Glen Kistenmacher;

(4)Hagen McMann; and

(5) Bill Simpson.

4-40 If a temporary director fails to qualify for office, the (b) 4-41 temporary directors who have qualified shall appoint a person to fill the vacancy. SECTION 9. CONFIRMATION AND INITIAL DIRECTORS' ELECTION. (a) The temporary board of directors shall call and hold an election to confirm the establishment of the district and to elect 4-45 4-46 4-47 4-48

five initial directors as provided by Section 49.102, Water Code.
 (b) The initial directors elected shall draw lots to decide 4-49 4-50 which two shall serve terms lasting until replacement directors are 4-51 elected at the first regularly scheduled election of directors under Section 10 of this Act and which three shall serve until the 4-52 4-53 second regularly scheduled election of directors.

(c) Section 41.001(a), Election Code, does not apply to a confirmation and initial directors' election held as provided by 4-54 4-55 4-56 this section.

4-57 ELECTION OF DIRECTORS. SECTION 10. (a) On the first Saturday in May of the first even-numbered year after the year in 4-58 4-59 which the district is authorized to be created at a confirmation 4-60 election, an election shall be held in the district for the election 4-61 of two directors to replace the two initial directors serving shorter terms from the confirmation election. 4-62

4-63 (b) On the first Saturday in May of each subsequent even-numbered year following the election, the appropriate number 4-64 4-65 of directors shall be elected.

4-66 SECTION 11. GENERAL POWERS. The district has all of the rights, powers, privileges, authority, functions, and duties provided by the general law of this state, including Chapter 54, 4-67 4-68 Water Code, applicable to municipal utility districts created under 4-69

Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution. 5-1 5-2

SECTION 12. PROHIBITION AGAINST IMPAIRMENT OF DISTRICT. A municipality in whose extraterritorial jurisdiction the district is located may not adopt an ordinance or resolution or take any other action that:

(1)impairs the ability of the district to exercise its powers under this Act; or

(2) limits the ability of the district to finance, construct, or operate its water, wastewater, or drainage systems.

SECTION 13. ANNEXATION. (a) A municipality may annex the district on the earlier of:

(1) the date of installation of 90 percent of all works, improvements, facilities, plants, equipment, and appliances necessary and adequate to:

provide service to the proposed development (A) within the district;

for (B) which accomplish the purposes the district was created; and

(C) exercise the powers provided by the general law of this state and this Act; or

(2) the 20th anniversary of the date the district is confirmed.

The district may add or exclude land in the manner (b) provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, without the consent of any municipality.

5-25 5-26 TO SECTION 14. REIMBURSEMENT LANDOWNER OR DEVELOPER; 5-27 INSTALLATION OF FACILITIES. If a municipality in whose extraterritorial jurisdiction the district is located annexes the district for full or limited purposes and the annexation precludes 5-28 5-29 5-30 or impairs the ability of the district to issue bonds, the 5-31 municipality shall: 5-32

(1) simultaneously with the annexation, pay in cash to the landowner or developer of the district a sum equal to all actual costs and expenses incurred by the landowner or developer in connection with the district that the district has, in writing, agreed to pay and that would otherwise have been eligible for reimbursement from bond proceeds under the rules and requirements of the commission as such rules and requirements exist on the date of annexation; and

(2) after the annexation, install all necessary water, and drainage facilities to serve full buildout of (2) 5-41 wastewater, development within the district.

5-43 SECTION 15. FINDINGS RELATED TO PROCEDURAL REQUIREMENTS. 5-44 The legal notice of the intention to introduce this Act, (a) setting forth the general substance of this Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a copy of this Act have been 5-45 5-46 furnished to all persons, agencies, officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished under Section 59, Article XVI, 5-47 5-48 Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, Government Code. The governor, one of the required recipients, has submitted the notice 5-49 5-50 5-51 and Act to the commission.

5-52 (b) The commission has filed its recommendations relating 5-53 to this Act with the governor, lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of representatives within the required time. 5-54

5-55 (c) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this 5-56 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect 5-57 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled 5-58 and accomplished.

SECTION 16. 5-59 EFFECTIVE DATE; EXPIRATION DATE. (a) This Act 5-60 takes effect September 1, 2003.

5-61 (b) If the creation of the district is not confirmed at a confirmation election held under Section 9 of this Act before 5-62 5-63 September 1, 2005, this Act expires on that date.

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
