H.B. No. 3565

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the creation, administration, powers, duties,
3 operation, and financing of the Lazy Nine Municipal Utility
4 District.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS. In this Act:

7 (1) "Board" means the board of directors of the
8 district.

9 (2) "District" means the Lazy Nine Municipal Utility
10 District.

11 SECTION 2. CREATION. (a) A municipal utility district, to
12 be known as the Lazy Nine Municipal Utility District, is created in
13 Travis County, subject to approval at a confirmation election under
14 Section 9 of this Act.

15 (b) The district is a governmental agency and a political
16 subdivision of this state.

17 SECTION 3. FINDINGS OF BENEFIT AND PUBLIC PURPOSE. (a) The
18 district is created to serve a public use and benefit.

19 (b) The district is created under and is essential to
20 accomplish the purposes of Section 59, Article XVI, Texas
21 Constitution.

22 (c) All of the land and other property included within the
23 boundaries of the district will be benefited by the works and
24 projects that are to be accomplished by the district under powers

1 conferred by Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

2 SECTION 4. BOUNDARIES. The boundaries of the district are
3 as follows:

4 A 1,719.449 acre tract of land out of and part of the following
5 eight (8) surveys: F. Sterzing survey no. 62, H. Pruett survey no.
6 51, Sam Wildy survey no. 527, c. J. Strother survey no. 606,
7 Seale-Morris & Seale survey no. 61, W. A. Barlow survey no. 86, J.
8 H. Johman survey no. 524 and E. Hallman survey no. 61, situated in
9 Travis County, Texas, being a portion of those certain tracts of
10 land called first tract and second tract conveyed to Mrs. O. H.
11 Davenport by deed of record in volume 1214, page 472 of the deed
12 records of Travis County, Texas (the "deed records"); said
13 1,719.449 acre tract being more particularly described by metes and
14 bounds as follows:

15 BEGINNING, at a concrete highway monument found in the southerly
16 right-of-way of State Highway No. 71 (R.O.W. varies), being the
17 northeasterly corner of that certain 453.54 acre tract of land
18 conveyed to Gregory A. Kozmetsky by deed of record in Volume 8132,
19 Page 262 of the Real Property Records of Travis County, Texas (The
20 "Real Property Records"), same being the most northerly corner of

6 of land called Tract 1 conveyed to Arthur Lee Sanders by deed of
7 record in Volume 8522, Page 125 of the Real Property Records, a
8 distance of 747.71 feet to a 1/2 inch iron pipe found at the
9 southwesterly corner of said Tract 1 for an angle point hereof;

10 THENCE, continuing along the northerly line hereof, along and with
11 a fence, being the northerly line of said First Tract, same being
12 the southerly line of said Tract 1, in part the southerly line of
13 said Tract 2, the southerly of that certain 2.34 acre tract of land
14 called Tract 3 conveyed to Arthur Lee Sanders by deed of record in
15 Volume 8522, Page 125 of the Real Property Records, the southerly
16 line of that certain 3.91 acre tract of land conveyed to John W.
17 Combs by deed of record in Volume 5829, Page 966 of the Deed
18 records, the southerly line of that certain 4.1 acre tract of land
19 conveyed to William Otto Combs by deed of record in Volume 2019,
20 Page 514 of the Deed Records and the southerly line of that certain
21 2.1 acre tract of land conveyed to William Otto Combs by deed of
22 record in Volume 1881, Page 194 of the Deed Records, the following

15 an angle point;
- 16 10) S89°11'36"E, a distance of 418.46 feet to a 1/2 inch iron pipe
17 found at the northwesterly corner of that certain 5.375 acre tract
18 of land conveyed to James Aaron Hudson by deed of record in Volume
19 12926, Page 2404 of the Real Property Records;
- 20 THENCE, continuing along the northerly line hereof, being the
21 northerly line of said First Tract, same being the westerly and
22 southerly lines of said Hudson 5.375 acre tract, the following two
23 (2) courses and distances:

25 found at the southwesterly corner of said Hudson 5.375 acre tract

22 5) Along said curve to the right having a radius of 1045.92 feet, a
23 central angle of $19^{\circ}27'13''$, an arc distance of 355.12 feet and a
24 chord which bears $S55^{\circ}12'32''E$, a distance of 353.42 feet to a 1/2
25 inch iron rod set with cap for the end of said curve;

26 6) $S45^{\circ}32'07''E$, a distance of 492.28 feet to a concrete highway
27 monument found for the point of curvature of a non-tangent curve to

- 1 the left;
- 2 7) Along said non-tangent curve to the left having a radius of
3 1245.92 feet, a central angle of $20^{\circ}04'19''$, an arc distance of
4 436.47 and a chord which bears $S55^{\circ}28'17''E$, a distance of 434.24
5 feet to a concrete highway monument found for the end of said curve;
- 6 8) $S65^{\circ}34'29''E$, a distance of 406.32 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod set
7 with cap for the point of curvature of a non-tangent curve to the
8 right;
- 9 9) Along said non-tangent curve to the right having a radius of
10 1045.92 feet, a central angle of $24^{\circ}05'24''$, an arc distance of
11 439.76 feet and a chord which bears $S53^{\circ}31'12''E$, a distance of
12 436.52 feet to a concrete highway monument found for the end of said
13 curve;
- 14 10) $S41^{\circ}34'34''E$, a distance of 372.97 feet to a concrete highway
15 monument found for the point of curvature of a non-tangent curve to
16 the left;
- 17 11) Along said non-tangent curve to the left having a radius of
18 1245.85, a central angle of $28^{\circ}41'02''$, an arc distance of 623.71 and
19 a chord which bears $S55^{\circ}51'42''E$, a distance of 617.21 feet to a 1/2
20 inch iron rod set with cap for the end of said curve;
- 21 12) $S70^{\circ}09'46''E$, a distance of 279.53 feet to a concrete highway
22 monument found for the point of curvature of a non-tangent curve to
23 the right;
- 24 13) Along said non-tangent curve to the right having a radius of
25 5629.58, a central angle of $07^{\circ}56'42''$, an arc distance of 780.63
26 feet and a chord which bears $S66^{\circ}12'39''E$, a distance of 780.00 feet
27 to a point for the end of said curve;

7 a fence angle for an angle point hereof;

8 9) S10°50'02"E, a distance of 84.28 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod set
9 with cap for an angle point;

10 10) S04°52'47"E, a distance of 298.75 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod
11 found at the southwesterly corner of said McCalla 122.61 acre
12 tract, being a point in the northerly line of that certain 327.341
13 acre tract of land conveyed to Henry R. Heffington by deed of record
14 in Volume 5246, Page 2045 of the Deed Records for the southeasterly
15 corner hereof;

16 THENCE, continuing along the southerly line hereof, being the
17 northerly line of said Heffington 327.341 acre tract, southerly

26 Property Records for an angle point;

27 THENCE, continuing along the southerly line hereof, being the

1 southerly line of said First Tract, same being in part the irregular
2 easterly and northerly lines of said 2601.5 acre Peacock tract,
3 continuing along and with a fence, the following five (5) courses
4 and distances:

5 1) N03°38'26"W, a distance of 638.53 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod set
6 with cap for an angle point;

7 2) N04°19'32"W, a distance of 752.53 feet to a cotton spindle found
8 at the northeasterly corner of said 2601.5 acre Peacock tract for an
9 angle point;

10 3) S88°17'27"W, a distance of 1347.71 feet to a fence post found
11 for an angle point;

12 4) S28°22'30"W, a distance of 730.45 feet to a cotton spindle found
13 for an angle point;

14 5) N61°34'59"W, a distance of 1595.89 feet to a fence post found in
15 the easterly line of that certain 320 acre tract of land called
16 Second Tract conveyed to William Michael Peacock by deed of record
17 in Volume 12851, Page 635 of the Real Property Records, being the
18 southwesterly corner of said First Tract for the southwesterly
19 corner hereof;

20 THENCE, along the westerly line hereof, being the westerly line of
21 said First Tract, same being in part the easterly and northerly
22 lines of said Peacock 320 acre tract, continuing along and with a
23 fence, the following two (2) courses and distances:

24 1) N26°42'35"E, a distance of 428.73 feet to a cotton spindle found
25 at the northeasterly corner of said Peacock 320 acre tract for an
26 angle point;

27 2) N62°04'20"W, a distance of 3584.02 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod

1 found at the southeasterly corner of that certain 109.733 acre
2 tract of land conveyed to Gregory A. Kozmetsky by deed of record in
3 Volume 7986, Page 412 of the Real Property Records for an angle
4 point;

5 THENCE, N28°15'21"E, continuing along the westerly line hereof,
6 being the westerly line of said First Tract, same being the easterly
7 line of said Kozmetsky 109.733 acre tract, a distance of 2638.72
8 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod found in the southerly line of said
9 Kozmetsky 453.54 acre tract, being the northeasterly corner of said
10 Kozmetsky 109.733 acre tract for an angle point;

11 THENCE, continuing along the westerly line hereof, being the
12 westerly line of said First Tract, same being in part the southerly
13 and easterly lines of said Kozmetsky 453.54 acre tract, continuing
14 along and with a fence, the following three (3) courses and
15 distances:

16 1) S61°52'07"E, a distance of 3589.01 feet to a fence post found at
17 the southeasterly corner of said kozmetsky 453.54 acre tract for an
18 angle point;

19 2) N28°13'55"E, a distance of 2904.91 feet to a fence post found
20 for an angle point;

21 3) N88°32'20"E, a distance of 1379.32 feet to the POINT OF
22 BEGINNING, containing an area of 1,719.449 acres (74,899,209 sq.
23 ft.) of land, more or less, within these metes and bounds.

24 SECTION 5. FINDINGS RELATIVE TO BOUNDARIES. The
25 legislature finds that the boundaries and field notes of the
26 district form a closure. If a mistake is made in the field notes or
27 in copying the field notes in the legislative process, the mistake

1 does not affect in any way:

2 (1) the organization, existence, or validity of the
3 district;

4 (2) the right of the district to impose taxes; or

5 (3) the legality or operation of the district or the
6 board.

7 SECTION 6. APPLICABILITY OF OTHER LAW. This Act prevails
8 over any provision of general law that is in conflict or
9 inconsistent with this Act.

10 SECTION 7. BOARD OF DIRECTORS. (a) The district is
11 governed by a board of five directors.

12 (b) Temporary directors serve until directors are elected
13 under Section 9 of this Act.

14 (c) Temporary directors of the district, or of a new
15 district created by division of the district under Section 13 of
16 this Act, are not required to own land in or be residents of the
17 district.

18 (d) Permanent directors serve staggered four-year terms.

19 (e) Each director must qualify to serve as director in the
20 manner provided by Section 49.055, Water Code.

21 SECTION 8. TEMPORARY DIRECTORS. (a) The temporary board
22 consists of:

23 (1) _____;

24 (2) _____;

25 (3) _____;

26 (4) _____; and

27 (5) _____.

1 (b) If a temporary director fails to qualify for office, the
2 temporary directors who have qualified shall appoint a person to
3 fill the vacancy. If at any time there are fewer than three
4 qualified temporary directors, the Texas Commission on
5 Environmental Quality shall appoint the necessary number of persons
6 to fill all vacancies on the board.

7 SECTION 9. CONFIRMATION AND INITIAL DIRECTORS' ELECTION.

8 (a) The temporary board shall call and hold an election to confirm
9 establishment of the district and to elect initial directors under
10 Section 49.102, Water Code.

11 (b) At the confirmation and initial directors' election the
12 board may submit to the voters a proposition to authorize:

- 13 (1) an issuance of bonds;
14 (2) a maintenance tax; or
15 (3) a tax to fund payments required under a contract.

16 (c) Section 41.001(a), Election Code, does not apply to a
17 confirmation and initial directors' election held as provided by
18 this section.

19 SECTION 10. ELECTION OF DIRECTORS. (a) On the first
20 Saturday in May of the first even-numbered year after the year in
21 which the district is authorized to be created at a confirmation
22 election, an election shall be held in the district for the election
23 of two directors to replace the two initial directors serving
24 shorter terms from the confirmation election.

25 (b) On the first Saturday in May of each subsequent
26 even-numbered year following the election, the appropriate number
27 of directors shall be elected.

1 SECTION 11. GENERAL POWERS. The district has all of the
2 rights, powers, privileges, authority, functions, and duties
3 provided by the general law of this state, including Chapters 30,
4 49, 50, and 54, Water Code, applicable to municipal utility
5 districts created under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas
6 Constitution.

7 SECTION 12. ANNEXATION. The board may annex land as
8 provided by Chapter 49 or Chapter 54, Water Code.

9 SECTION 13. DIVISION OF DISTRICT. (a) Notwithstanding any
10 other law, either before or after annexing land into the district
11 under Section 12 of this Act, and before issuing indebtedness
12 secured by taxes or net revenues, the board may divide the territory
13 of the district, including any annexed territory, into two or more
14 new districts.

15 (b) A new district created by division of the district must
16 be at least 100 acres in size.

17 SECTION 14. ELECTION FOR DIVISION OF DISTRICT. (a) On a
18 board resolution consenting to the terms and conditions of a
19 division under Section 13 of this Act, including a plan for payment
20 and performance of any outstanding obligations of the district, and
21 a metes and bounds description of the proposed new districts, the
22 board shall order an election to be held in the district to
23 determine if the district should be divided as proposed.

24 (b) The board shall give notice of the election not later
25 than the 20th day before the election in the manner provided by
26 Section 49.102, Water Code.

27 (c) Not later than the 30th day after the date of the

1 election the district shall provide written notice of the plan for
2 division to:

- 3 (1) the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality;
- 4 (2) the attorney general;
- 5 (3) the commissioners court of each county in which
6 each new district is located; and
- 7 (4) any municipality having extraterritorial
8 jurisdiction over the land within each new district.

9 SECTION 15. GOVERNANCE OF DISTRICTS AFTER DIVISION. (a) On
10 a vote of a majority of the qualified electors in the district in
11 favor of dividing the district in an election held under Section 14
12 of this Act, the district shall be divided.

13 (b) The resulting new districts shall be assigned
14 consecutive letters, corresponding to the number of the new
15 district.

16 (c) The resulting new districts shall be separate districts
17 and shall be governed as separate districts.

18 (d) Until the 91st day after the date of the election
19 approving the division of the district, the board shall continue to
20 act on behalf of the district to wind up the affairs of the
21 district.

22 SECTION 16. ELECTION OF DIRECTORS OF NEW DISTRICT. (a)
23 After an election approving the division of the district, the
24 directors of the board shall:

- 25 (1) continue to act as directors of one of the new
26 districts; and
- 27 (2) appoint temporary directors for each of the other

1 new districts not later than the 90th day after the date of the
2 election approving the division of the district.

3 (b) Temporary directors appointed under Subsection (a) of
4 this section shall serve until an election for permanent directors
5 is held on the next uniform election date under Section 41.001(a),
6 Election Code. The temporary directors of each new district must
7 qualify under Section 49.055, Water Code, not later than the 90th
8 day after the date of the election approving the district. The
9 temporary directors shall take office at the expiration of this
10 90-day period.

11 (c) On election of directors under Subsection (b) of this
12 section, the three directors receiving the greatest number of votes
13 shall serve until May of the first even-numbered year that is four
14 years after the date of the election and two directors shall serve
15 until May of the first even-numbered year that is two years after
16 the date of the election.

17 (d) The board of each new district shall approve the bond of
18 each of its directors.

19 SECTION 17. CONTINUING POWERS AND OBLIGATIONS OF NEW
20 DISTRICTS. (a) Each new district shall have the power to incur and
21 pay debts and shall in every respect have the full power and
22 authority of the district created and governed by this Act.

23 (b) If the district is divided in an election under Section
24 14 of this Act, the current obligations and any bond authorizations
25 of the district are not impaired. The debts shall be paid by taxes,
26 revenues, or assessments levied on the land in the district as if
27 the district had not been divided or by contributions from each new

1 district on terms stated and agreed to in the division plan proposed
2 by the board and approved by an election under Section 14 of this
3 Act.

4 (c) Any other obligation of the district shall be divided
5 pro rata among the new districts on an acreage basis or on other
6 terms that are satisfactory to the new districts.

7 SECTION 18. CONTRACT AUTHORITY OF NEW DISTRICTS. The new
8 districts may contract with each other for water, wastewater, and
9 any other matters the board of each new district considers
10 appropriate.

11 SECTION 19. BOND ISSUANCE BY NEW DISTRICT. (a) A new
12 district that is created as a result of an election approving the
13 division of the district as provided by Section 14 of this Act may
14 issue bonds payable wholly or partially from ad valorem taxes on the
15 approval of a majority of the residents voting in an election called
16 and held for that purpose.

17 (b) Notice of the bond election shall be given as provided
18 by Section 49.106, Water Code.

19 SECTION 20. MAINTENANCE TAX APPROVAL FOR NEW DISTRICT. A
20 new district that is created as a result of an election approving
21 the division of the district as provided by Section 14 of this Act
22 may levy a maintenance tax on the approval of a majority of the
23 residents voting in an election called and held for that purpose.

24 SECTION 21. FINDINGS RELATED TO PROCEDURAL REQUIREMENTS.

25 (a) The legal notice of the intention to introduce this Act,
26 setting forth the general substance of this Act, has been published
27 as provided by law, and the notice and a copy of this Act have been

1 furnished to all persons, agencies, officials, or entities to which
2 they are required to be furnished under Section 59, Article XVI,
3 Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, Government Code. The
4 governor, one of the required recipients, has submitted the notice
5 and Act to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

6 (b) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
7 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor,
8 lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of representatives
9 within the required time.

10 (c) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
11 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
12 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
13 and accomplished.

14 SECTION 22. EFFECTIVE DATE; EXPIRATION DATE. (a) This Act
15 takes effect September 1, 2003.

16 (b) If the creation of the district is not confirmed at a
17 confirmation election held under Section 9 of this Act before
18 September 1, 2005, this Act expires on that date.
