1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the Moore County Juvenile Board.

1-9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-10 SECTION 1. Sections 152.1771(a), (b), and (e), Human
1-11 Resources Code, are amended to read as follows:

1-12 (a) The Moore County Juvenile Board is composed of:

1-13 (1) the county judge; and

1-14 (2) six [~~two~~] persons appointed by the Moore County
1-15 Commissioners Court[~~+~~

1-16 [~~(3) two persons appointed by the Dumas City
1-17 Commission; and~~

1-18 [~~(4) two persons appointed by the board of trustees of
1-19 the Dumas Independent School District~~].

1-20 (b) The appointed members serve staggered two-year terms
1-21 with the terms of three members [~~one person appointed by the city,
1-22 one person appointed by the county, and one person appointed by the
1-23 school district~~] expiring on December 31 of each even-numbered
1-24 year, and the terms of three members expiring on December 31 of each
1-25 odd-numbered year.

1-26 [~~(c) The commissioners court, the Dumas City Commission,
1-27 and the board of trustees of the Dumas Independent School District
1-28 may agree to pay equally the costs of the salaries and expenses of
1-29 the juvenile department.~~]

1-30 SECTION 2. The two persons appointed by the Moore County
1-31 Commissioners Court serving on the Moore County Juvenile Board
1-32 immediately before the effective date of this Act shall serve the
1-33 remainder of their terms. The first four persons appointed on or
1-34 after the effective date of this Act to serve on the Moore County
1-35 Juvenile Board as provided by Section 152.1771(a), Human Resources
1-36 Code, as amended by this Act, shall draw lots for staggered terms,
1-37 so that the terms of three of the six appointed members expire
1-38 December 31 of each even-numbered year, and the terms of the other
1-39 three of the six appointed members expire December 31 of each
1-40 odd-numbered year.

1-41 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
