Sec. 30.01882. JUDGE. The governing body of the city may 10 determine by ordinance whether a municipal judge is appointed by 11 12 the governing body or elected by the qualified voters of the city by 13 a majority vote. A municipal judge serves for a term of three 14 years. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2003. 19
