- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 25.1132(c) and (e), Government Code,
- 6 are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) A county court at law in Hood County has concurrent
- 8 jurisdiction with the district court in:
- 9 (1) civil cases in which the matter in controversy
- 10 exceeds \$500 but does not exceed \$250,000, excluding interest;
- 11 (2) family law cases and related proceedings; [and]
- 12 (3) contested probate matters under Section 5(b),
- 13 Texas Probate Code; and
- 14 (4) contested guardianship matters under Section
- 15 606(b), Texas Probate Code.
- (e) Except as provided by Subsection (c)(3) or (4), a county
- 17 court at law does not have probate jurisdiction.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
