11	(2) family law cases and related proceedings; [and]
12	(3) contested probate matters under Section 5(b),
13	Texas Probate Code <u>; and</u>
14	(4) contested guardianship matters under Section
15	606(b), Texas Probate Code.
16	(e) Except as provided by Subsection (c)(3) or (4), a county
17	court at law does not have probate jurisdiction.
18	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
