A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the boundaries of the Baytown Area Water Authority and
- 3 the validation of actions taken by the board of directors of the
- 4 authority.

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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 4, Chapter 600, Acts of the 63rd
- 7 Legislature, Regular Session, 1973, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 4. The authority shall comprise all of the territory
- 9 contained within the following described tracts [area]:
- 10 TRACT ONE:
- 11 BEGINNING at a point on the South right-of-way line of Interstate
- 12 Highway No. 10, said point being at the intersection of the Easterly
- 13 shoreline of the San Jacinto River;
- 14 THENCE, in a Southerly direction following the Easterly shoreline
- of the San Jacinto River to a point of intersection with a line
- 16 which is parallel to and 2500 feet from the centerline of the
- 17 Houston Ship Channel;
- 18 THENCE, in a Southeasterly direction along a line which is parallel
- 19 to and 2500 feet from the centerline of the Houston Ship Channel to
- 20 a point of intersection with the West shoreline of Burnett Bay;
- 21 THENCE, in a Northeasterly direction along the shoreline of Burnett
- 22 Bay, and continuing along the shoreline of Burnett Bay to its
- 23 juncture with the shoreline of Crystal Bay, and continuing along
- 24 the shoreline of Crystal Bay to its juncture with the shoreline of

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- 1 Scott Bay, and continuing along the shoreline of Scott Bay to a
- 2 point of intersection with a line which is parallel to and 2500 feet
- 3 from the centerline of the Houston Ship Channel;
- 4 THENCE, in a Southeasterly direction along the line which is
- 5 parallel to and 2500 feet from the centerline of the Houston Ship
- 6 Channel to a point of intersection with the shoreline of Black Duck
- 7 Bay;
- 8 THENCE, in an Easterly direction along the shoreline of Black Duck
- 9 Bay, and continuing along the shoreline of Black Duck Bay to the
- 10 mouth of Goose Creek, and continuing across the mouth of Goose Creek
- 11 to the shoreline of Tabbs Bay, and then continuing along the
- 12 shoreline of Tabbs Bay to a point of intersection with the West line
- 13 of Cedar Bayou;
- 14 THENCE, in a Northerly direction along the West line of Cedar Bayou
- to a point of intersection with the North right-of-way line of State
- 16 Farm-Market Highway No. 2354;
- 17 THENCE, in a Southeasterly direction, crossing Cedar Bayou along
- 18 the Northeasterly right-of-way line of State Farm-Market Highway
- 19 No. 2354, and continuing along the Northerly right-of-way line of
- 20 State Farm-Market Highway No. 2354 nearly seven miles to a point
- 21 approximately 315 feet Southwest of a 5/8 inch iron rod having a
- 22 Texas Plane [plane] Coordinate value of x=3,315,954.08,
- y=710,156.88;
- 24 THENCE, North 74 degrees 10 minutes 00 seconds West a distance of
- 532.84 feet to a point marked by a 5/8 inch iron rod;
- 26 THENCE, North 15 degrees 50 minutes 00 seconds East a distance of
- 27 299.96 feet to a point marked by a 5/8 inch iron rod;

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- 1 THENCE, South 74 degrees 10 minutes 00 seconds East a distance of
- 2 629.00 feet to a point marked by a 5/8 inch iron rod, said point
- 3 being on the Westerly right-of-way line of State Farm-Market
- 4 Highway No. 2354 and said iron rod having a Texas Plane Coordinate
- 5 [plane coordinate] value of x=3,315,954.08, y=710,156.88;
- 6 THENCE, continuing in a Northerly direction along the Westerly
- 7 right-of-way line of State Farm-Market Highway No. 2354 and its
- 8 extension across State Farm-Market Highway No. 565 to a point of
- 9 intersection with the South right-of-way line of Interstate Highway
- 10 No. 10;
- 11 THENCE, in a Westerly direction along the South right-of-way line
- 12 of Interstate Highway No. 10 to a point of intersection with the
- 13 Easterly shoreline of the San Jacinto River, said point of
- intersection being the POINT OF BEGINNING.
- 15 TRACT TWO:
- 16 That area bounded by Interstate Highway No. 10 on the south, State
- 17 Farm-Market Highway No. 565 on the east, Barbers Hill Road and its
- 18 westerly extension on the north, and the San Jacinto River on the
- 19 west.
- 20 SECTION 2. (a) The legislature validates and confirms all
- 21 governmental acts and proceedings of the Baytown Area Water
- 22 Authority and the authority's board of directors that occurred
- 23 before the effective date of this Act.
- 24 (b) This section does not apply to any matter that on the
- 25 effective date of this Act:
- 26 (1) is involved in litigation if the litigation
- 27 ultimately results in the matter being held invalid by a final

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- 1 judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction; or
- 2 (2) has been held invalid by a court of competent
- 3 jurisdiction.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
