> A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to the boundaries of the Baytown Area Water Authority and the validation of actions taken by the board of directors of the authority.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 4, Chapter 600, Acts of the 63rd Legislature, Regular Session, 1973, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 4. The authority shall comprise all of the territory

contained within the following described tracts [area]:

TRACT ONE:

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1-40 1-41 1-42 BEGINNING at a point on the South right-of-way line of Interstate Highway No. 10, said point being at the intersection of the Easterly shoreline of the San Jacinto River;

THENCE, in a Southerly direction following the Easterly shoreline of the San Jacinto River to a point of intersection with a line which is parallel to and 2500 feet from the centerline of the Houston Ship Channel;

THENCE, in a Southeasterly direction along a line which is parallel to and 2500 feet from the centerline of the Houston Ship Channel to a point of intersection with the West shoreline of Burnett Bay;

THENCE, in a Northeasterly direction along the shoreline of Burnett Bay, and continuing along the shoreline of Burnett Bay to its juncture with the shoreline of Crystal Bay, and continuing along the shoreline of Crystal Bay to its juncture with the shoreline of Scott Bay, and continuing along the shoreline of Scott Bay to a point of intersection with a line which is parallel to and 2500 feet from the centerline of the Houston Ship Channel;

THENCE, in a Southeasterly direction along the line which is parallel to and 2500 feet from the centerline of the Houston Ship Channel to a point of intersection with the shoreline of Black Duck Bav

THENCE, in an Easterly direction along the shoreline of Black Duck Bay, and continuing along the shoreline of Black Duck Bay to the mouth of Goose Creek, and continuing across the mouth of Goose Creek to the shoreline of Tabbs Bay, and then continuing along the shoreline of Tabbs Bay to a point of intersection with the West line of Cedar Bayou;

1-43 THENCE, in a Northerly direction along the West line of Cedar Bayou 1-44 1-45 to a point of intersection with the North right-of-way line of State 1-46 Farm-Market Highway No. 2354;

1 - 47THENCE, in a Southeasterly direction, crossing Cedar Bayou along the Northeasterly right-of-way line of State Farm-Market Highway No. 2354, and continuing along the Northerly right-of-way line of State Farm-Market Highway No. 2354 nearly seven miles to a point approximately 315 feet Southwest of a 5/8 inch iron rod having a 1-48 1-49 1-50 1-51 of 1-52 x=3,315,954.08Texas Plane [<del>plane</del>] Coordinate value 1-53 y=710,156.88;

1-54 THENCE, North 74 degrees 10 minutes 00 seconds West a distance of 532.84 feet to a point marked by a 5/8 inch iron rod; 1-55

1-56 THENCE, North 15 degrees 50 minutes 00 seconds East a distance of 1-57 299.96 feet to a point marked by a 5/8 inch iron rod;

THENCE, South 74 degrees 10 minutes 00 seconds East a distance of 629.00 feet to a point marked by a 5/8 inch iron rod, said point being on the Westerly right-of-way line of State Farm-Market Highway No. 2354 and said iron rod having a Texas Plane Coordinate 1-58 1-59 1-60 1-61

1-62 [plane coordinate] value of x=3,315,954.08, y=710, $\overline{156.88}$ ;

THENCE, continuing in a Northerly direction along the Westerly right-of-way line of State Farm-Market Highway No. 2354 and its 1-63 1-64

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extension across State Farm-Market Highway No. 565 to a point of 2 - 1intersection with the South right-of-way line of Interstate Highway 2-2 No. 10;

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THENCE, in a Westerly direction along the South right-of-way line of Interstate Highway No. 10 to a point of intersection with the Easterly shoreline of the San Jacinto River, said point of 2-5 2-6 intersection being the POINT OF BEGINNING. 2-7

2-8 TRACT TWO:

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That area bounded by Interstate Highway No. 10 on the south, State Farm-Market Highway No. 565 on the east, Barbers Hill Road and its westerly extension on the north, and the San Jacinto River on the west.

- SECTION 2. (a) The legislature validates and confirms all governmental acts and proceedings of the Baytown Area Water Authority and the authority's board of directors that occurred before the effective date of this Act.
- (b) This section does not apply to any matter that on the effective date of this Act:
- (1) is involved in litigation if the litigation ultimately results in the matter being held invalid by a final judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction; or

  (2) has been held invalid by a court of competent
- jurisdiction.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

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
