## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the rights, powers, privileges, authority, functions,
- 3 and duties of the Dallas County Water Control and Improvement
- 4 District No. 6.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. DEFINITION. In this Act, "district" means the
- 7 Dallas County Water Control and Improvement District No. 6.
- 8 SECTION 2. AUTHORITY. The district is a water conservation
- 9 and reclamation district created under Section 59, Article XVI,
- 10 Texas Constitution, and converted in 1981 to a municipal utility
- 11 district governed by Chapter 54, Water Code.
- 12 SECTION 3. GENERAL POWERS. The district has all of the
- 13 rights, powers, privileges, authority, functions, and duties
- 14 provided by the general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and
- 15 54, Water Code, applicable to municipal utility districts created
- 16 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution. This Act
- 17 prevails over any provision of general law that is in conflict or
- 18 inconsistent with this Act.
- 19 SECTION 4. ADDITIONAL POWERS. (a) The district has the
- 20 additional rights, powers, privileges, authority, and functions
- 21 provided by this section.
- (b) To the extent authorized by Section 52, Article III,
- 23 Texas Constitution, the district may provide for the construction,
- 24 maintenance, and operation inside or outside the boundaries of the

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- 1 district of:
- 2 (1) macadamized, graveled, or paved roads and
- 3 turnpikes; or
- 4 (2) works, facilities, or improvements related to the
- 5 roads and turnpikes.
- 6 SECTION 5. BONDS. (a) The district may issue bonds, notes,
- 7 or other obligations of the district to finance construction,
- 8 maintenance, and operation under Section 4 of this Act and may
- 9 impose a tax to pay the principal of or interest on bonds issued
- 10 under this subsection.
- 11 (b) The district may not issue bonds under Subsection (a) of
- 12 this section unless the issuance is approved by a vote of a
- 13 two-thirds majority of the qualified voters of the district or of a
- 14 defined area in the district under Subchapter J, Chapter 54, Water
- 15 Code, if applicable, voting at an election called for that purpose.
- 16 Bonds, notes, or other obligations issued or incurred under
- 17 Subsection (a) of this section may not exceed one-fourth of the
- 18 assessed value of the real property in the district or in the
- 19 defined area in the district, if applicable.
- 20 (c) Sections 49.181, 49.182, and 50.107, Water Code, do not
- 21 apply to projects undertaken by the district under Section 4(b) of
- 22 this Act or to bonds issued by the district under Subsection (a) of
- 23 this section.
- SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
