2 Wildcats in Fort Worth has captured his 1,275th victory to become
3 the nation's most successful boys' high school basketball coach;

5 WHEREAS, Achieving his 22nd 30-win season in a career that
6 has spanned 45 years, Coach Hughes led his Wildcats to a 71-62 win
7 over district rival Polytechnic High School before a capacity crowd
8 at Texas Christian University's Daniel-Meyer Coliseum; this
9 victory gave his team the district title and made him the
10 winningest high school basketball coach in America; and

11 WHEREAS, Coach Hughes occupies a lofty position within the
12 high school coaching profession; reflecting the high esteem in
13 which he is held, the Fort Worth Independent School District
14 recently honored him by christening Robert Hughes Court at
15 Wilkerson-Greines Activity Center; and

16 WHEREAS, Inspiring his players to excellence, Coach Hughes
17 has made lasting contributions to his students and has left his mark
18 on high school sports history; now, therefore, be it
