CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Providing support services to older workforce
2 development participants is a common goal of the Texas Workforce
3 Commission and the Texas Department on Aging; and

4 WHEREAS, The Texas Workforce Commission and local workforce
5 development boards provide job seekers with information about
6 support services such as transportation assistance; and

7 WHEREAS, The Texas Department on Aging and local area
8 agencies on aging provide connections to an array of support
9 services, and the staff is knowledgeable about the needs of older
10 workers; and

11 WHEREAS, Local workforce development boards are charged with
12 forming working relationships with local entities, agencies, and
13 institutions that provide support services to workforce
14 development participants; and

15 WHEREAS, Local area agencies on aging are charged with
16 providing information to older Texans about federal, state, and
17 local support services, including workforce services; and

18 WHEREAS, A memorandum of understanding between the Texas
19 Workforce Commission and the Texas Department on Aging would
20 promote an integrated, effective workforce system; now, therefore,
21 be it

22 RESOLVED, That the 78th Legislature of the State of Texas
23 hereby encourage the Texas Workforce Commission and the Texas
24 Department on Aging to establish a memorandum of understanding and

1 a process to promote local partnerships relevant to a coordinated
2 delivery of support services to older workforce development
3 participants; and, be it further

4 RESOLVED, That the secretary of state forward a copy of this
5 resolution to the executive directors of the Texas Workforce
6 Commission and the Texas Department on Aging.
