CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 Jack W. Coe of Alvin retired from Rohm and Haas Texas Incorporated
3 on March 14, 2003; and

20 Manufacturers Association (EHCMA) board of directors since 1986; in
21 this endeavor, he has chaired a number of committees and now serves

24 years, he received the Rohm and Haas Vice President's Award in 1997

1 and 1998, as well as the EHCMA Chairman's Award in 1998; and

2 WHEREAS, In addition to crafting a successful career, he has
3 been blessed with a loving family; he and his wife of 43 years,
4 Dorothy, are the parents of four children, and they have proudly
5 watched their family grow to include 12 grandchildren; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Coe may take pride in knowing that he has been a
7 significant force in Deer Park's petrochemical industry, and he
8 will be sorely missed by his colleagues; now, therefore, be it

9 RESOLVED, That the 78th Legislature of the State of Texas
10 hereby congratulate Jack W. Coe on his retirement from Rohm and Haas
