CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Big Bend National Park was officially established on June 12, 1944, six months after Texas Governor Coke Stevenson signed a deed of cession giving the National Park Service (NPS), United States Department of the Interior, exclusive jurisdiction over the park; and

6 WHEREAS, Exclusive jurisdiction, whereby the federal 7 government possesses all of the authority of the state, was ceded by 8 the State of Texas at the request of then-Secretary of the Interior 9 Harold Ickes; and

10 WHEREAS, The NPS also has jurisdiction over a 196-mile 11 section of the Rio Grande designated by congress as part of the 12 National Wild and Scenic Rivers System and administered by Big Bend 13 National Park; and

14 WHEREAS, The General Authorities Act of 1976 required the NPS 15 to seek to acquire concurrent legislative jurisdiction for all 16 units of the National Park System to allow the United States and the 17 states to exercise joint regulatory authority; and

18 WHEREAS, Concurrent legislative jurisdiction provides for 19 more efficient conduct of state and federal law enforcement 20 functions, improving visitor safety and resource protection at 21 national parks; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the 78th Legislature of the State of Texas hereby respectfully request the Congress of the United States to direct the National Park Service, United States Department of the

Interior, to acquire concurrent legislative jurisdiction for Big
Bend National Park and the Rio Grande Wild and Scenic River; and, be
