HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The City of Mineola is developing the Mineola
Preserve on the Sabine River to protect and enhance a richly diverse
natural area; and

WHEREAS, Containing 2,921 acres, the preserve offers an unusual opportunity for birders to view, within the boundaries of one site, the avian fauna of several different East Texas ecotypes; visitors to the Mineola Preserve can wander through a patchwork landscape composed of uplands, lowland pastures, young bottomland and mature bottomland forests, and successional woodlands; and

10 WHEREAS, This wide range of habitat and vegetation types is 11 capable of attracting as many as 218 different species of birds; to 12 date, the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD) has verified 13 the occurrence of 75 species, and it is continuing verification 14 work at the site to develop a comprehensive listing; and

WHEREAS, Among the native or migratory species present at the 15 preserve may be some that are now considered to be "threatened"; one 16 such species is the swallow-tailed kite, a bird listed by TPWD as 17 threatened in Texas and a species of concern for bird initiatives in 18 the Lower Mississippi Valley Joint Venture; swallow-tailed kites 19 have been observed at the nearby Old Sabine Bottom Wildlife 20 21 Management Area, making it highly likely that they can be sighted in the Mineola Preserve; and 22

23 WHEREAS, A master plan for conserving and promoting the area 24 is in development by several governmental and nongovernmental

1 organizations, including Ducks Unlimited and the Audubon Society; 2 and

3 WHEREAS, In order to make the tract and its treasures 4 accessible to the public, amenities will include a variety of 5 trails and a number of wildlife viewing stations; complementing the 6 gravel trails will be a two-mile-long all-weather path along a 7 raised, abandoned railroad bed, which traverses each of the 8 preserve's ecotypes; discussion is also underway regarding the 9 possibility of establishing an Audubon Center at the site; and

10 WHEREAS, The Mineola Preserve has been nominated for 11 inclusion on the new Prairies and Pineywoods Wildlife Trail; a 12 project of the TPWD, the trail is designed to help travelers find 13 the best wildlife-viewing sites in North and East Texas; and

14 WHEREAS, Affording ample opportunities for recreation, 15 inspiration, and research to all who cherish the out-of-doors, the 16 Mineola Preserve constitutes an exceptionally valuable asset to 17 birders, and the City of Mineola is committed to protecting this 18 property for the education and enjoyment of all Texans and visitors 19 to the Lone Star State; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the 78th Legislature of the State of Texas
21 hereby recognize Mineola as the Birding Capital of East Texas.
