

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, House Bill No. 4 has been adopted by the house of  
2 representatives and the senate and is being prepared for  
3 enrollment; and

4 WHEREAS, The bill contains technical errors that should be  
5 corrected; now, therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED by the 78th Legislature of the State of Texas, That  
7 the enrolling clerk of the house be instructed to correct House Bill  
8 No. 4 as follows:

9 (1) On page 63, line 26, between "the" and "health", insert  
10 "physician or".

11 (2) On page 64, line 11, between "\$250,000" and the period,  
12 insert "for each claimant".

13 (3) On page 64, line 17, between "\$250,000" and "and",  
14 insert "for each claimant".

15 (4) On page 64, line 21, between "\$500,000" and the period,  
16 insert "for each claimant".

17 (5) On page 65, line 3, between "the" and "health", insert  
18 "physician or".

19 (6) On page 65, line 16, between "\$250,000" and the period,  
20 insert "for each claimant".

21 (7) On page 65, line 22, between "\$250,000" and "and",  
22 insert "for each claimant".

23 (8) On page 65, line 26, between "\$500,000" and the period,  
24 insert "for each claimant".

1           (9) On page 26, line 9, after the word "fact.", strike the  
2 remaining sentence and add a new Subsection (d) to read as follows:  
3 "An election made under Subsection (c) shall be made by any  
4 defendant filing a written election before the issues of the action  
5 are submitted to the trier of fact and, when made, shall be binding  
6 on all defendants. If no defendant makes this election or if  
7 conflicting elections are made, all defendants are considered to  
8 have elected Subsection (c)(1)."
