A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to provide for a six-year term for a board member of an
- 3 intermunicipal commuter rail district.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 30, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 7 <u>(e) The Legislature by general law may provide that members</u>
- 8 of the board of an intermunicipal commuter rail district serve
- 9 terms not to exceed six years, with one-third, or as near as
- one-third as possible, of the members of the board to be appointed
- 11 every two years.
- 12 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 13 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2003.
- 14 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 15 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 16 legislature to provide for a six-year term for a board member of an
- 17 intermunicipal commuter rail district."
