A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to authorize the legislature
- 2 to exempt certain travel trailers from ad valorem taxation.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 1(j), Article VIII, Texas Constitution,
- 5 is amended to read as follows:
- 6 (j) The Legislature by general law may [authorize a taxing
- 7 unit, other than a school district, to] exempt from ad valorem
- 8 taxation [by the taxing unit,] a travel trailer, as defined by the
- 9 Legislature, regardless of whether the travel trailer is real or
- 10 personal property, that:
- 11 (1) on January 1 of the applicable tax year is
- 12 registered in this state in compliance with the laws of this state
- 13 relating to the registration of vehicles; and
- 14 (2) is not held or used for the production of income.
- 15 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to
- 16 the Texas Constitution:
- 17 TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) This temporary provision applies to
- 18 the constitutional amendment proposed by __J.R. No. ___, 78th
- 19 Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, and expires January 2, 2004.
- 20 (b) The amendment to Section 1(j), Article VIII, of this
- 21 constitution takes effect beginning with the tax year that begins
- 22 January 1, 2004.
- 23 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2003.

- 2 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to authorize the
- 3 legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation travel trailers that
- 4 are registered in this state and are not held or used for the
- 5 production of income."
