## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to exempt certain travel trailers that are registered in this state
- 3 from ad valorem taxation.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1(j), Article VIII, Texas Constitution,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (j) The Legislature by general law may [authorize a taxing
- 8 unit, other than a school district, to] exempt from ad valorem
- 9 taxation [by the taxing unit,] a travel trailer, as defined by the
- 10 Legislature, regardless of whether the travel trailer is real or
- 11 personal property, that:
- 12 (1) on January 1 of the applicable tax year is
- 13 registered in this state in compliance with the laws of this state
- 14 relating to the registration of vehicles; and
- 15 (2) is not held or used for the production of income.
- 16 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2003.
- 18 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 19 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 20 legislature to exempt certain travel trailers that are registered
- 21 in this state from ad valorem taxation."
