A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment providing for authorization
- of the issuing of notes or the borrowing of money on a short-term
- 3 basis by a state transportation agency for transportation-related
- 4 projects.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 49-m to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 49-m. (a) The legislature, by law, may authorize the
- 9 Texas Transportation Commission or its successor to authorize the
- 10 Texas Department of Transportation or its successor to issue notes
- or borrow money from any source to carry out the functions of the
- 12 <u>department</u>.
- 13 (b) Notes issued or a loan obtained under this section may
- 14 not have a term of more than two years. The legislature may
- appropriate money dedicated by Sections 7-a and 7-b, Article VIII,
- of this constitution for the purpose of paying a debt created by the
- 17 notes or loan.
- 18 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 19 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2003.
- 20 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 21 proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing for
- 22 authorization of the issuing of notes or the borrowing of money on a
- 23 short-term basis by a state transportation agency for
- 24 transportation-related projects."
