A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment relating to the structure,
- 2 powers, and duties of the State Board of Education.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 8, Article VII, Texas Constitution, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 8. The [Legislature shall provide by law for a] State
- 7 Board of Education consists of[, whose] members [shall be appointed]
- 8 or elected from districts contiguous with the boundaries of
- 9 congressional districts in this state who[in such manner and by
- 10 such authority and] shall serve staggered four-year [for such]
- 11 terms[as the Legislature shall prescribe not to exceed six years].
- 12 The [said] board shall:
- 13 <u>(1) administer and direct public education in this</u>
- 14 state;
- 15 (2) appoint a commissioner of education to serve at
- 16 the will of the board;
- 17 (3) appoint board officers, including the presiding
- 18 officer; and
- 19 <u>(4)</u> perform such duties as may be prescribed by law.
- 20 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 21 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2003.
- 22 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 23 proposition: "The constitutional amendment relating to the
- 24 structure, powers, and duties of the State Board of Education."
