## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing municipalities to

- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 52i to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 52i. (a) A municipality may donate surplus equipment,
- 8 supplies, or other materials used in fighting fires to the Texas
- 9 Forest Service or to a successor agency authorized to cooperate in
- the development of rural fire protection plans.
- 11 (b) The Texas Forest Service or the successor agency may,
- based on need, redistribute to rural volunteer fire departments the
- equipment, supplies, or materials donated under Subsection (a).
- 14 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2003.
- 16 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 17 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing
- 18 municipalities to donate surplus fire-fighting equipment or
- 19 supplies for the benefit of rural volunteer fire departments."
