## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment requiring the state to provide
- 2 for equitable funding for each student under the public school
- 3 system.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article VII, Texas Constitution, is amended by 6 adding Section 1A to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1A. In meeting its duty under Section 1 of this article
- 8 to make suitable provision for the support and maintenance of an
- 9 efficient system of public free schools, the Legislature shall
- 10 provide for a system that results in the availability of an
- 11 equitable amount of total state and local funding for maintenance,
- 12 operations, and facilities costs to provide an equal educational
- opportunity for each student with comparable educational needs.
- 14 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2003.
- 16 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 17 proposition: "The constitutional amendment requiring the state to
- 18 provide for a public school system that results in equal
- 19 educational opportunity and equitable funding for each student with
- 20 comparable educational needs."
