A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to remove the prohibition
- 2 against perpetual trusts.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 26, Article I, Texas Constitution, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 26. Perpetuities and monopolies are contrary to the
- 7 genius of a free government, and shall never be allowed, nor shall
- 8 the law of primogeniture or entailments ever be in force in this
- 9 State. This section does not apply to perpetual trusts.
- 10 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 11 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2003.
- 12 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 13 proposition: "The constitutional amendment removing the
- 14 prohibition against perpetual trusts."
