A JOINT RESOLUTION

proposing a constitutional amendment to allow the legislature to
authorize and govern the operation of wineries in this state.

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 20, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is 5 amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

6 (d) The legislature may enact laws and direct the Alcoholic Beverage Commission or its successor to set policies for all 7 wineries in this state, regardless of whether the winery is located 8 9 in an area in which the sale of wine has or has not been authorized by local option election, for the manufacturing of wine, including 10 11 the on-premises selling of wine to the ultimate consumer for 12 consumption on or off the winery premises, the buying of wine from or the selling of wine to any other person authorized under general 13 14 law to purchase and sell wine in this state, and the dispensing of wine without charge, for tasting purposes, for consumption on the 15 winery premises, and for any purpose to promote the wine industry in 16

17 this state.

SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be submitted to the voters at an election to be held September 13, 20203. The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the proposition: "A constitutional amendment to allow the legislature to enact laws authorizing and governing the operation of wineries in this state."
