## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to allow a local option
- 2 election to legalize or prohibit the sale of mixed beverages in
- 3 certain special districts.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 20, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) The legislature may enact a law to allow the qualified
- 8 voters in an improvement district that is a political subdivision
- 9 to determine by a majority vote whether the sale of mixed alcoholic
- 10 beverages in a food service establishment shall be prohibited or
- 11 legalized in the prescribed limits of the district.
- 12 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 13 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2003.
- 14 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- proposition: "The constitutional amendment to allow an improvement
- 16 district that is a political subdivision to hold a local option
- 17 election to legalize or prohibit the sale of mixed alcoholic
- 18 beverages in a food service establishment in the district."
