R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Nacogdoches County Day at the Capitol is being held  
2 January 22, 2003, in celebration of this significant area of our  
3 state; and

4           WHEREAS, While the State of Texas counts six flags over the  
5 course of its history, nine flags have flown over this illustrious  
6 county; inhabited by Caddo Indians in historic times, the area was  
7 later occupied by Spanish missionaries and Spanish settlers before  
8 the arrival of Anglo-Americans in the 1820s; and

9           WHEREAS, The county seat, Nacogdoches, holds the distinction  
10 of being the oldest city in Texas, having received from Mexico its  
11 official designation as a pueblo in 1779; the city has played a  
12 prominent role in the history of our state, with a stone house, now  
13 known as the Old Stone Fort, figuring in three attempts to establish  
14 a Republic of Texas; and

15           WHEREAS, A compelling tourist destination, Nacogdoches  
16 County encompasses parts of the Sam Rayburn Reservoir and Angelina  
17 National Forest, both popular sites for camping, hiking, and  
18 fishing; the annual Blueberry Festival, a highly anticipated event  
19 filled with family fun, celebrates the county's flourishing  
20 blueberry industry; and

21           WHEREAS, This fertile, forested region has provided  
22 residents with prosperous agribusiness and with thriving timber,  
23 poultry, and dairy production; higher education also plays a  
24 positive role in the local economy, for the county is home to the

1 respected Stephen F. Austin State University, and the influx of  
2 students infuses the area with a youthful vitality; and

3 WHEREAS, A place of natural beauty and charm, Nacogdoches  
4 County has long contributed to the development and special  
5 character of Texas, and it continues to be an outstanding asset to  
6 the Lone Star State; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas  
8 Legislature hereby recognize January 22, 2003, as Nacogdoches  
9 County Day at the State Capitol and extend a warm welcome to those  
10 citizens of the county who are with us today.
