WHEREAS, Among his contributions in the area of law enforcement and public safety are the creation of Zebra Squad, the state's first parole violators task force; A.S.A.P, a truancy reduction program; and Precinct 6's GREAT-BIG, or Gang Resistance Education & Training-Bicycle Initiative Goal program; he also began the first volunteer bicycle patrol program, in-service training
