16 Target Hunger, Share the Spirit of the Texas Gulf Coast, and the  
17 Norton Church of God in Christ and the Buck Street Memorial Church  
18 of God in Christ; Mrs. Cornett is also the founder of the Joy of  
19 Awakening Youth Life Planning Center in Houston and authored and  
20 produced many plays for area youth; and
