3 Award for his many contributions to his community; and

8 University, Indiana University, and Auburn University, Dr.

10 Dallas; he previously served as president of Bishop College in
11 Dallas and Schenectady County Community College in New York; and

12 WHEREAS, Dr. Lassiter has also been an educator and
13 administrator at Morgan State University in Baltimore, Tuskegee
14 University in Alabama, Dallas Baptist University, The University of
15 Texas at Austin, and Texas A&M University; and

16 WHEREAS, This distinguished gentleman is recognized as a
17 leader in his community and has served on the boards of many worthy
18 organizations, including the Methodist Medical Center, the
19 Salvation Army, the YMCA Foundation, and the African American
20 Museum, where he is currently chairman of the board; and

21 WHEREAS, Dr. Lassiter was honored in 1989 when President
22 George Bush appointed him to the U.S. Commission on Minority
23 Business Development and again in 2002 when President George W.
24 Bush nominated him for service as a member of the National Advisory

1 Council to the National Endowment for the Humanities; and

2 WHEREAS, With a list of achievements too numerous to mention,
3 Dr. Lassiter has justly received significant accolades throughout
4 the years; a devoted husband, father, and grandfather, and role
5 model to many, this fine gentleman is truly worthy of being named an
6 Outstanding Texan; now, therefore, be it
