

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Jelynn LeBlanc Burley, assistant city manager for  
2 San Antonio, has been chosen to receive an Outstanding Texan Award  
3 by the Texas Legislative Black Caucus; and

4           WHEREAS, Ms. Burley is being recognized in the Professional  
5 Category for her signal achievements during an 18-year career with  
6 the City of San Antonio; in her present post, Ms. Burley directs the  
7 city's initiatives in neighborhood investment and inner-city  
8 revitalization, an assignment that involves oversight of the  
9 Neighborhood Action, Housing and Community Development, Code  
10 Compliance, and Planning departments; and

11           WHEREAS, Previous service in the Public Works, Parks and  
12 Recreation, and Budget and Research departments contributed to Ms.  
13 Burley's comprehensive understanding of city affairs; other  
14 responsibilities and accomplishments that have distinguished her  
15 tenure with the city have included guiding the small business  
16 advocacy program for the Alamodome Development Office, organizing  
17 the city's first Affordable Housing Parade of Homes, and assisting  
18 in developing the objectives of the Housing Section of the San  
19 Antonio Master Plan; and

20           WHEREAS, Before her appointment as assistant city manager,  
21 Ms. Burley served as director of the Convention Center Expansion  
22 Office, in which capacity she oversaw the \$11.7 million development  
23 of the International Center and the \$218 million expansion and  
24 renovation of the Henry B. Gonzalez Convention Center; and

1           WHEREAS, In all her endeavors, Ms. Burley enjoys the love and  
2 support of her husband, Roy Burley, Jr., and their two children,  
3 Crystal and Juliet; and

4           WHEREAS, Through her consummate expertise and her manifold  
5 efforts in behalf of the citizens of San Antonio, Jelynné Burley has  
6 contributed immeasurably to the betterment of the Alamo City, and  
7 it is indeed a privilege to recognize her at this time; now,  
8 therefore, be it

9           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas  
10 Legislature hereby congratulate Jelynné LeBlanc Burley on her  
11 receipt of an Outstanding Texan Award from the Texas Legislative  
12 Black Caucus and honor her for her commitment to strengthening the
