## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The Texas House of Representatives is proud to 2 welcome members of the Texas Organization of Rural and Community 3 Hospitals, or TORCH, to the Capitol; and

WHEREAS, Established in 1990, TORCH is the only hospital association dedicated to meeting the needs of rural and small community hospitals in Texas; made up of general acute care hospitals with fewer than 150 beds, TORCH bridges the gap between rural and urban providers; and

WHEREAS, Of the 254 counties in Texas, 196 are considered rural; of these counties, 61 have no hospital, 105 have one hospital, 27 have two hospitals, and 4 have three hospitals; 176 Texas counties have been designated as medically underserved areas, and an additional 47 counties have been designated as partial medically underserved areas; and

WHEREAS, Some 3.1 million Texans live in our state's rural regions, and these Lone Star citizens deserve to have access to high quality medical care; the members of TORCH have lived up to their motto, "Big enough to help, Small enough to care," and it is a privilege to have delegates from this group with us today; now, therefore, be it
