

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Transportation investment to ensure mobility
2 throughout Texas is essential to maintaining the economic vitality
3 of the Lone Star State and the quality of life of Texans; and

4 WHEREAS, Reports indicate that the current level of funding
5 supports only about a third of the identified transportation
6 project needs in Texas; and

7 WHEREAS, In its 2002 urban mobility report, the Texas
8 Transportation Institute cites data illustrating alarming
9 increases in congestion, delay, and costs associated with traveling
10 in Texas' major urban areas; and

11 WHEREAS, Highway safety, connectivity, and system
12 reliability are issues important to citizens throughout Texas, and
13 concerned citizens have expressed a desire to designate a single
14 day during this session for focus on the importance of
15 transportation and mobility in Texas; now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas
17 Legislature hereby recognize February 26, 2003, as Texas
18 Transportation Day at the State Capitol and welcome those
19 individuals who have traveled to Austin to take part in this daylong
20 event.
